This features Trucking Fleet Operators licensed by the Department of Transportation. A Department of Transportation (DOT) number is a number the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, or FMCSA, assigns to registered commercial vehicles. All carrier vehicles that weigh more than a certain amount, carry specific amounts of paying passengers or operate between state lines require DOT numbers. In most U.S. states, local DOT requirements also apply.

DOT certification is a seal of quality that shows a driver has the skills and competence to drive commercial vehicles on America's roads and highways. Most states require DOT certification to drive commercial vehicles — a category that includes semi-trucks, delivery vehicles and public transportation.

To have a commercial driver's license, as opposed to a personal driver's license, you must become DOT certified. Most fleet drivers require a commercial driver's license because it serves as proof a job applicant has received DOT certification.

To become DOT certified, a driver must undergo a physical exam and a series of safe-driving tests. The U.S. Department of Transportation administers DOT certification. Commercial vehicle operators must reapply for DOT certification every two years.
